Site of the Battle of 1866

The 1866 War Museum, along with the educational trails and almost five hundred monuments in the vicinity, paints a perfect picture of one of the bloodiest battles of the 19th century. Who emerged victorious from the Prussian-Austrian conflict is a matter known to many, what the consequences of this victory were and what preceded it all, you can best find out directly at the scene of the battle, i.e. in Chlum near Hradec Králové.

It is a highly popular destination not only for filmmakers, but especially for engaged couples, and also for the treats from the chateau café *Kavárna Anny z Harrachu*, a popular destination for foodies.

KARLOVA KORUNA – This chateau is known not only for its original marble hall, where you would have a difficult time finding a corner, but also for the tradition of dog hunts, which has been associated with the Kinsky family and Chlumec Chateau for almost 200 years.

NOVÝ BYDŽOV – The city of student snacks has become famous, among other things, for an interesting motorcycle event. Where did the name for Nový Bydžov square come from? The unmistakable geometric plan of Masarykovo náměstí Square has been the place for more than a quarter of a century where fifty vintage cars race in the *Eliška Junková Memorial*.

Prehistoric Archaeology Park

The unique multifunctional area offers a real journey back to prehistoric times.
